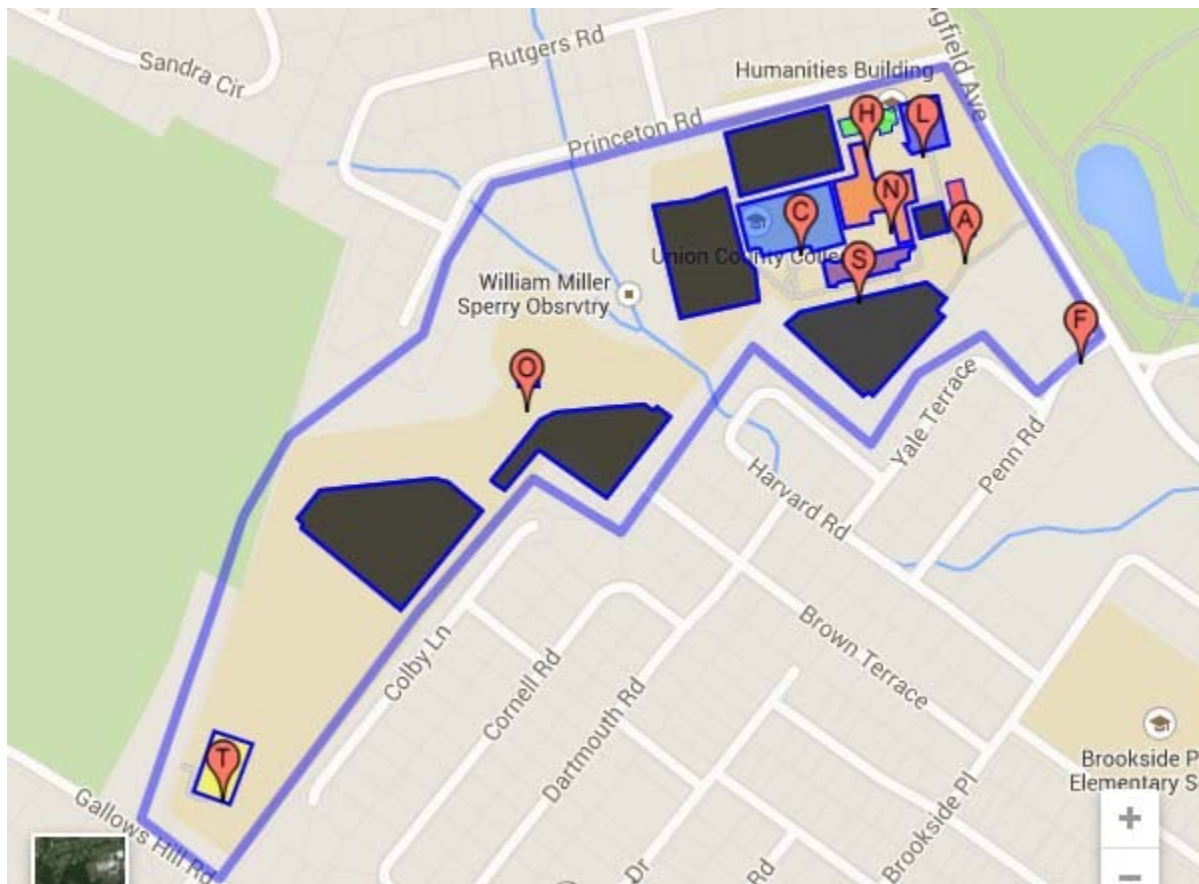


Shea-Jennings Feis Information

May 14, 2016

Location: Union County College 1033 Springfield Avenue Cranford, NJ 07016

See map below. Building C (blue block in center) on the map is the Campus Center and The Victor M. Richel Student Commons. All feis activities take place in this building. There is plenty of parking in the campus lots (gray blocks on map).



Feis Day Information: Doors will open at 8am. Competitions begin at 8:45am sharp. Dancers in the first competitions should be dressed and lined up by 8:35am.

When you enter the Campus Center building, there is a large open common seating area. The entry table, vendors and awards will be set up in this area and the hallway. Please note, this is a public building. There will be classes in session on campus Saturday morning, so there will be students and non-feis participants in the building. You are free to hang out here, but **NO CAMPING** and **DO NOT** leave your items (or your children) unattended.

Stages: **Stage A** will be in the Roy Smith Theater. The theater is through the common area and to the left down the hallway. This is an auditorium with theater seating. Please use the seating in theater and do not camp in hallways.

Stages 1, 2 and Stage B will be in the Gymnasium. The Gymnasium is located down the hallway past the Roy Smith Theater. Bleachers will be available for seating. **Please leave chairs home! There will be No CAMPING in hallways.**

Cafeteria/Vending Machines: The Cafeteria is down the hallway to the right of the Common area. The cafeteria is open to our attendees and students **until 4pm**. Vending machines are available throughout the common area for snacks/drinks, and you are free to bring in your own food.

Competitor #'s: Numbers will be posted on our website and available for printing by Thursday evening. If you owe \$ you will need to pick up your number at the feis.

Vendors: Vendors will be set up in the common area. Head for the World, Fays, and Feis Head will be there.

Local Area: Directly across Springfield Avenue from the Campus there is a great park and playground. If it's a nice day and you are looking to entertain younger children or just want to enjoy a picnic lunch, it's a great playground with picnic tables.

If you exit the front of the school and turn right onto Springfield Avenue, follow Springfield out to North Avenue and turn right onto North, this will lead you into downtown Cranford. Here you will find many great restaurants & shopping.

If you exit the back of the school and turn right onto Gallows Hill Road, and then left on East Broad Street, this will lead you into downtown Westfield. Westfield has numerous great restaurants for dinner and big name stores (Lord & Taylor, Urban Outfitters, Gap, etc.) for great shopping.
