DIRECTIONS

From The Garden State Parkway South - Take exit 135. Bear right off exit onto Central Avenue. At the first light, turn left onto Raritan Road and go to the end (the name of the road changes to Oak Ridge Road and then to Featherbed Lane). Turn right onto Inman Avenue. Wardlaw-Hartridge is 2 miles on the left.

From The Garden State Parkway North - Take exit 131 and bear right onto Route 27 South. Turn right at the second light onto Wood Avenue. Turn left at the third light onto Inman Avenue. Wardlaw-Hartridge is 2 ½ miles on the left.

From Philadelphia, Pa – Take NJ Turnpike North to Exit 11, Garden State Parkway North. Follow directions above.
