Tuition should be paid in full regardless of absences due to a child not feeling well or other activities (sports, school plays, family vacations, December concerts, etc.) There are several compatible make up classes for each level (ask your teacher). In the event that a dancer needs surgery and will be out for an <u>extended period of time</u> other arrangements can be made. Make up classes do not expire and you can make up your classes on your own time frame. Withdrawal – One month written notice or email is required if your child withdraws from the dance school.

Calendar – All holidays are scheduled into the calendar. Monthly fees are prorated based on the average number of classes per

month for the school year. CLASS PRICES * Note * Due to covid-19, some class times have been reduced by fifteen minutes due to smaller numbers of

dancers allowed in the studio. Reducing class sizes from what would usually be 10 -15 dancers to now 5 - 8...increases safety and also productivity thus making class times more appropriately timed for the dancers. Also, due to the novel corona virus, dancers must wear masks (making physical activity more strenuous which is also another reason class times need to be shortened.) Finally, we will be adding fifteen minutes between each class to reduce coming in and out traffic and to clean and air out the facility.

Preliminary and Open Championship (classes Monday - Thursday and Saturday) ---- \$160 per month One month notice is required for withdrawal from the program. We can not allow holiday concerts, sports, injuries or sickness to be a reason to not pay your tuition. By signing this form, you agree to pay for the entire year regardless of attendance as we offer MANY make up classes throughout the year. You can not

take a two month break and then return and deduct your missed classes. This is a highly salaried program of our school and we have to pay employees regardless of attendance. Thank you for understanding.

Tuition Options - For your convenience, two payment options are available:

1.) Monthly Payment – Tuition is due each month on the 15th. Please drop a check in our box at the studio on the wall when you walk in to your right or Venmo **Deirdre-Shea-4**

2.) Full year – Pay your full year tuition and get <u>one month free</u>. (This is NON-refundable)

Registration Fee – There is a \$25 dollar registration fee per family. This fee is Non-refundable. Minimum registration payment: At registration, should you choose the months payment option, you will be required to pay September tuition plus one month security payment. Students registering during the year will also pay first month tuition plus one month security. Security will be used to cover unpaid fees upon withdrawal or will be applied to June tuition. Therefore if you are up to date on all your payments, DO NOT write us a check for June.

At registration you will be paying September + June + \$25 registration fee.
